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The Key Call system is the latest technology used to call waiting customers in fast food and fast casual restaurants. Instead of handing customers costly pagers, you can now hand them inexpensive plastic cards. The customer then takes the card to any table and activates the pager unit that is fixed to the table. No matter what table the customer chooses to sit at, they will know silently when their order is ready.

Simple Operation:

- 1 Give the customer the numbered card at time of order.
- 2 Customer inserts and removes the card into the Key Call unit located at any table. (The Key Call unit is now programmed to the customer's "pager number".)
- 3 When the meal is ready, the Key Call device is paged by the server from a transmitter.
- 4 The Key Call unit at the table lights up and displays the customer's pager number.
- 5 The customer returns the card and picks up the order.

Features:

- Each Key Call unit can store up to 8 pager numbers to accommodate large parties with multiple orders.
- Waterproof design for outside usage
- Operates on (3) AA batteries so there is no recharging required
- Operates for months without changing the batteries
- Large double-sided number readout for "all-angle" viewing
- Optional speaker with 4 voice messages
- Built-in holder for salt/pepper and sugar box
- Optional transmitter for quicker table delivery service
